Into the Word:

1) What is one takeaway from the message that really impacted you?

Read 1 Samuel 13:5-6, then 13:15, 13:22, then finally vs 14:1-14

2) What are some valid reasons for Jonathan to be uncertain about the outcomes he is facing?

3) What are some reasons for Jonathan to believe he could win the battle?

4) Israel was living under Philistine control due to their own sin and disobedience. Why could a new courageous leader be an instrument for God to change this situation?

5) In your own words, describe how Jonathan dealt with uncertainty in this situation? What would his "method" be?

Apply the Word:

6) What can we learn from Jonathan to apply to our own lives about uncertainty?

7) What area of your life has uncertainty? Describe it and how it is difficult or challenging.

8) How can this group pray for you and support you to go forward trusting in God?
