The Prayer Project - Part 5

PARTICIPANT GUIDE

Into the Word:

*If you were in the line at the grocery and a friend who missed the message asked what it was about, how would you describe it? (60 seconds or less)

Read Acts 4:23-31

a) What aspect or attribute of God's character is the disciples' prayer based on? Why is it important to pray in accordance with God's character as revealed in Scripture and the Gospel?

b) In verse 28b they reference God predestining the death of Jesus. How does God's sovereignty serve to encourage prayer?

c) Why do they not pray for the threats and opposition (see Acts 4:1-4) to end?

d) Why is their greatest need 'boldness' and not protection?

Apply the Word:

a) How does your mindset regarding prayer change when you believe that your prayers are "how" God brings about what is inevitable in His Kingdom?

b) In the message, we were asked to check 3 things: for unbelief; for passion; and for alignment.

--Where are you struggling to believe God's inevitable promises?

--Where are you more passionate about what is possible over what God has decreed is inevitable?

--Where do you need to align your prayers for what is possible with what is inevitable?

c) Share 1-2 ways your prayer has or is changing as a result of *The Prayer Project*? How can the group help you in this?

d) Share who you are praying for this Easter.

Prayer Time:

--Spend time praying by name for people your group identifies as being lost or out of church.

--Pray for 2 Thessalonians 3:1 over our Easter weekend services
