Into the Word:

* What was the one biggest takeaway for you from the message that you might share with someone who might need to hear it?

Read Luke 5:27-32

a) What do you think it was like for Matthew that day, when Jesus interrupted his work? Brainstorm as a group: were there likely other tax-collectors with him? Possibly Roman Soldiers? What else might have been going on?

b) What were the range of emotions might Matthew have been feeling at the booth?

c) At the party for Jesus, what do you think the atmosphere was like, and what did the party reveal about Matthew's heart?

d) In the message, Matt talked about availability revealing the priority of our hearts, such as what we are truly holding on to. What does this story reveal about Matthew?

Apply the Word:

a) From the sermon, what were the main obstacles to availability that you noticed or wrote down?

b) How would you describe your daily availability to God's interruptions? And how would you know if you are available or not?

c) What might be holding back your availability? Your own sinfulness? Your busyness or commitments in life? What needs to change to give God more?
