## Proposed Time Guideline -

- Drop off/Snack Time/Relationship building/Talking about their week (10 mins)
- Book Activity/Discussion (40 mins)
- Prayer time (5 mins)

This week we will be continuing in the book by: Kay Arthur and Janna Arndt - "How to study your Bible for Kids." Again, How can you lead with excellence? The best thing you can do as a Kid's Club Leader is to read over and study the lessons before you come on Sunday. Reading this guide each week will give you insight to what you will be teaching the kids + reading over the pages of the book will help you be fully equipped and ready to lead the kids in how to get the most out of studying God's Word.

This is a 6 week study with 5 days of material in each week. We will some weeks do just one day and others we will be doing more than a day worth of material if we feel like it is a light week. Activities that involve the kids doing puzzles and writing in the book will be provided with printed materials for each kid or we will use a blank piece of paper for them to answer questions that you will ask them. This guide will provide those answers for you to lead them with confidence.

A leadership encouragement; how can you grow as a leader? Doing this study along with them to learn/know/grow. God can use the things we are teaching/leading children to help us grow in our faith and walk with Him. So, consider doing the study yourself to prepare each week, and watch how God can grow you in leadership and relationship.

**Supplies Needed:** Bibles (Each kid), Workbook, Pen/Pencil, Colored Pencils, Index Cards, Dictionary, and printed crossword puzzles worksheets.

**\*Encourage kids to bring their Bible from home or talk with your Campus Children's Minister about kids that may need assistance in getting their own Bible.**

Now, we are ready to dive back into this Mystery as Bible Detectives on Page 24 of the workbooks "Day Four - Track Them Down, Sam!" We are going to flip to Titus 2 in our Bibles. Read, and mark every reference to Titus in chapter two just like we did in chapter one. They will have the crossword printable, but you can ask them the questions example "#1 Across: Titus 2:1, WHAT are you to speak? Things fitting for sound \_\_\_\_\_" (Answer: Doctrine) The answers for you are located on page 148 of the workbook.

After the crossword activity, we will finish the lesson by doing "Day Five - Let's Close the Case" We are going to turn to Titus Chapter 3 - Mark every reference to Paul & Titus like in Chapter 1 & 2 (Author of the book in blue - Recipient of the letter in orange \*Page 17 of workbook to review how to mark\*)

Pages 27-29: Use the book to ask questions and have the kids just answer them as a group.

- Pray with them before dismissal.
