Prisoner In Chains

Matthew 28:20b – “And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age.”

When Paul and Silas were thrown into prison, they were put into a prison cell and chained up. Can you imagine how scary or frustrating that must have been? But Paul and Silas did not lose heart. Instead of worrying or complaining, they chose to worship God and pray! Matthew 28:20 tells us that God is always with us no matter where we are! When we pray and talk to God about whatever situation we are facing, it brings us closer to him knowing that he hears us and is with us. Today we are going to make paper chains reminding us of this truth.

Supplies: paper chain template, crayons or markers, scissors, tape or stapler

Directions: Print out the paper chain template. Print each page of the template on a different color of paper. You can also choose to print the template on white paper and color your paper chain instead. Use scissors to cut out each strip of paper for your chain. With either tape or a stapler, make rings with your strips of paper and fasten them together putting the Bible verse in order.
