**Bible Story:** The Wise and Foolish Builders • Matthew 7:24-27

**Bottom Line:** You can HEAR from God.

**Memory Verse:** "Let us keep looking to Jesus. He is the one who started this journey of faith. And he is the one who completes the journey of faith." Hebrews 12:2a (NirV)

## PET ROCKS

**What You Need:** A rock (the smoother the better); googly eyes; paint and a paint brush; glue or other adhesive for googly eyes.

### What You Do:

*Before the Activity:* Have kids go outside and find a rock. The smoother the rock the better so that they can attach googly eyes. Set up a spot where you don't mind if kids get paint.

*During the Activity:* Explain that kids will create pet rocks! Encourage kids to use the paint provided to paint the rock as they choose. Use the glue or other adhesive to adhere the googly eyes to the rock and draw or paint a mouth.

*After the Activity:* Place rocks in a spot where they can dry for a few hours.

### What You Say:

*Before the Activity:* "Today we heard a story about a wise man who built his house upon the rock. Let's paint some of our own rocks, BUT I want you to do something a little crazy. Let's paint our rocks to look like pets. So we need to make sure they have eyes and a mouth. Use the paints to decorate your rock any way you'd like. Then add two googly eyes and draw in a mouth!"

*After the Activity:* "I love your pet rocks! Jesus told a very important story about a man who built his house on the sand and a man who built his house on what? (Pause.) Yes, the rock! Jesus teaches us so many important things. When you look at your pet rock this week, remember this story Jesus told to help us make wise choices and stand strong."
