Matthew 6:19-20

“Don’t store up for yourselves **treasures on earth**, where moth and rust destroy and where thieves break in and steal. But store up for yourselves **treasures in heaven**, where neither moth nor rust destroys, and where thieves don’t break in and steal.

Be a wise **investor → Factor in **eternity**.**

Matthew 6:21

Matthew 6:22-23

Matthew 6:24

“**No one** can serve **two** masters, since either he will hate one and love the other, or he will be devoted to one and despise the other. You cannot serve **both** God and money.

We seek Him **first** because He is **first** and His Kingdom is **everlasting**.

Matthew 6:25-31

“Therefore I tell you: Don’t worry about your life, what you will eat or what you will drink; or about your body, what you will wear. Isn’t life more than food and the body more than clothing? Consider the birds of the sky: They don’t sow or reap or gather into barns, yet your **heavenly Father** feeds them. Aren’t you worth more than they? Can any of you add one moment to his life span by worrying? And why do you worry about clothes? Observe how the wildflowers of the field grow: They don’t labor or spin thread. Yet I tell you that not even Solomon in all his splendor was adorned like one of these. If that’s how God clothes the grass of the field, which is here today and thrown into the furnace tomorrow, won’t he do much more for you—you of little faith? So don’t worry, saying, ‘What will we eat?’ or ‘What will we drink?’ or ‘What will we wear?’

If we can call God **Father**, why does stress get our **best**??

We cannot live our **2nd Mile Purpose** with **1st mile priorities**.

Matthew 6:32

For the **Gentiles** eagerly seek all these things, and your **heavenly Father** knows that you need them. But seek **first** the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be provided for you.

Priority is tied to **purpose** (~2nd Mile)

1) Vision (Kingdom & Father) → Devotion (treasure)

2) Discipline follows devotion
