#### Matthew 5:41

And if anyone forces you to go one mile, go with him two.

Be the type of person who is not controlled by their situation and the people around them.

Be the type of person who sees adversity as opportunity.

Be the type of person who rejects the typical (and justifiable) reaction and instead gives a blessing.

#### <u>John 3:3</u>

"Truly I tell you, unless someone is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God."

#### Colossians 3:10

Put on your <u>new nature</u>, and be renewed as you <u>learn</u> to know your Creator and <u>become</u> like Him.

#### Matthew 5:42-47

Give to the one who asks you, and don't turn away from the one who wants to borrow from you.

"You have heard that it was said, *Love your neighbor and hate your enemy*. But I tell you, love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you, so that you may be <u>children of your Father</u> in heaven. For he causes his sun to rise on the evil and the good, and sends rain on the righteous and the unrighteous. For if you love those who love you, what reward will you have? Don't even the tax collectors <u>do the same</u>? And if you greet only your brothers and sisters, what are you doing <u>out of the ordinary</u>? Don't even the Gentiles do the same?

People see us on the first mile; they see Jesus (through us) on the 2<sup>nd</sup>!
