John 1:12

But to all who did <u>receive</u> Him, He gave them the right to be <u>children of God</u>, to those who <u>believe</u> in <u>His Name</u> ...

1) We must know Who He really is ("...believe in His Name ...")

Not every Jesus is the real Jesus ... →SHOW With the MANGER & CROSS GRAPHIC

John 1:1-4

In the beginning was the <u>Word</u>, and the Word was with God, and the <u>Word was God</u>. 2 He was with God in the beginning. 3 All things were <u>created</u> through Him, and apart from Him not one thing was created that has been created. 4 In Him was <u>life</u>, and that life was the <u>light</u> of men.

Jesus:

A Part of my life? Addition to my life? OR my life?

2) We must know our condition.

John 1:5, 10-11

That light shines in the darkness, and yet the darkness did not overcome it ... ¹⁰ He was in the world, and the world was created through Him, and yet the world did not recognize Him. ¹¹ He came to His own, and His own people did not receive Him.

John 3:19-20

This is the verdict: Light has come into the world, but people <u>loved darkness</u> instead of light because their deeds were evil. ²⁰ Everyone who does evil <u>hates the light</u>, and will not come into the light for fear that their deeds will be exposed.

Our greatest problem: a lack of righteousness and a preference for darkness

We have to see the mess we are in ("darkness) before we can appreciate the God we have.

3) We must know God's provision.

John 1:12-13

But to all who did receive Him, He gave them the right to be children of God, to those who believe in His Name, ¹³ who were born, not of natural descent, or of the will of the flesh, or of the will of man, but of God.

John 1:14

The Word became flesh and dwelt among us. We observed His glory, the glory as the one and only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth.

2 Corinthians 5:21 → SHOW THIS WITH THE CROSS IMAGE

God made Him (*Jesus Christ*) who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in Him we might become the righteousness of God.
