2 Chronicles 29:1-2

Hezekiah was twenty-five years old when he became king, and he reigned twenty-nine years in Jerusalem. His mother's name was Abijah daughter of Zechariah. ² He did what was right in the Lord's sight just as his ancestor David had done.

2 Chronicles 28:1-3

Ahaz was twenty years old when he became king, and he reigned sixteen years in Jerusalem. He did not do what was right in the Lord's sight like his ancestor David, ² for he walked in the ways of the kings of Israel and made cast images of the Baals. ³ He burned incense in Ben Hinnom Valley and burned his children in the fire, imitating the detestable practices of the nations the Lord had dispossessed before the Israelites.

1) The Difference: to swim upstream (not going with the flow)

2 Chronicles 29:3

In the <u>first year</u> of his reign, in the <u>first month</u>, he opened the doors of the <u>Lord's temple</u> and repaired them.

2) The Difference: to start with God

What about pressing problems? Pressing Needs? Pressing possibilities?

First priority, first importance and first love are always first.

Matthew 6:33a

But seek <u>first</u> the kingdom of God and his righteousness ...

1 Corinthians 15:3-5

For what I received I passed on to you as of <u>first importance</u>: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, ⁴ that He was buried, that He was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures, ⁵ and that He appeared to Cephas, and then to the Twelve.

Revelation 2:4

... I {Jesus} have this against you, that you have left your first love.

First priority, first importance and first love are always first.

The goal is NOT to try and get God on our side ...

3) The Difference: to start immediately & specifically

If first is always first, then we do not have to wait for a "feeling", an "Ah Ha" moment, a crisis, a consequence or judgement.

2 Chronicles 29:4-5

Then he brought in the priests and Levites and gathered them in the eastern public square. ⁵ He said to them, "Hear me, Levites. Consecrate yourselves now and consecrate the temple of the Yahweh, the God of your ancestors. Remove everything impure from the holy place.

4) The Difference: to take the path of consecration

The path is <u>rigorous</u> because the goal is <u>magnificent!</u>!

Revelation 22:11-17

Let the unrighteous go on in unrighteousness; let the filthy still be filthy; let the righteous go on in righteousness; let the holy still be holy." ¹² "Look, I am coming soon, and My reward is with me ... ¹³ I am the Alpha and the Omega, the first and the last, the beginning and the end. ¹⁴ "Blessed are those who wash their robes, so that they may have the right to the tree of life and may enter the city by the gates. ¹⁵ Outside are the dogs, the sorcerers, the sexually immoral, the murderers, the idolaters, and everyone who loves and practices falsehood. ¹⁶ "I, Jesus, have sent My angel to attest these things to you for the churches. Lam the Root and descendant of David, the bright morning star."

¹⁷Both the Spirit and the bride say, "Come!" Let anyone who hears, say, "Come!" Let the one who is thirsty come. Let the one who desires take the water of life freely.

2 Chronicles 29:6-9

For our ancestors were unfaithful and did what is evil in the sight of the Lord our God. They abandoned Him, turned their faces away from the Lord's dwelling place, and turned their backs on Him. ⁷ They also closed the doors of the portico, extinguished the lamps, did not burn incense, and did not offer burnt offerings in the holy place of the God of Israel. ⁸ Therefore, the wrath of the Lord was on Judah and Jerusalem, and He made them an object of terror, horror, and mockery, as you see with your own eyes. ⁹ Our fathers fell by the sword, and our sons, our daughters, and our wives are in captivity because of this.

Danger: Being held captive by a lesser story.

Some things only get dealt with when we get both serious and intentional about the Lord.

2 Chronicles 29:10-11

It is in my heart <u>now</u> to make a <u>covenant</u> with the Yahweh, the God of Israel so that His burning anger may turn away from us. ¹¹ My sons, <u>don't be negligent now</u>, for the Lord has chosen you to stand in His presence, to serve Him, and to be His ministers and burners of incense."

God's mercy does not lower the standard, but His standard does not diminish His mercy.

5) The Difference: A powerful and eternal Why ...

I Chronicles 16:10-11

Boast in His holy name; let the hearts of those who <u>seek the Lord</u> rejoice. ¹¹ <u>Seek the Lord</u> and His strength; <u>seek His face</u> always.
