## Hebrews 11:6

Mark 8:27-28

Jesus went out with His disciples to the villages of Caesarea Philippi. And on the road he asked his disciples, "Who do people say that I am?" <sup>28</sup> They answered Him, "John the Baptist; others, Elijah; still others, one of the prophets."

#### Mark 8:29

"But you," He asked them, "who do you say that I am?" Peter answered Him, "You are the Messiah."

## "Messiah"

- Anointed One □ Davidic king
  - Historical King
  - Ultimate King

Jesus/God wants to be recognized ... to be fully & truly known.

What if the problem is our awareness or perception?

#### Mark 8:30

And He strictly warned them to tell no one about him.

#### Mark 8:31-32a

Then He began to teach them that it was necessary for the Son of Man to suffer many things and be rejected by the elders, chief priests, and scribes, be killed, and rise after three days. <sup>32</sup> He spoke openly about this.

## Mark 8:32b

Peter took Him aside and began to rebuke Him.

Jesus/God wants to "show up" but we tell Him how He has to do it.

God's presence now becomes His absence.

In this case of "Missing Jesus," Jesus did not meet Peter's <u>expectation</u> and contradicted Peter's <u>agenda</u>.

#### **Nationalism:**

Putting love of nation and associated self-interests over love of God.

# Christian Nationalism in America:

Seeing America as crucial and essential to God's kingdom Seeking to tie the Gospel to a specific society, political party, and government

## Acts 10:34-35

Peter began to speak: "Now I truly understand that God doesn't show favoritism, <sup>35</sup> but in every nation the person who fears him and does what is right is acceptable to him.

#### Mark 8:33

But turning around and looking at His disciples, He <u>rebuked</u> Peter and said, "Get behind me, <u>Satan!</u> You are not thinking about God's concerns but <u>human concerns</u>."

When awareness of God increases so too does satanic activity.

- 1: Masquerading as an angel of light (2 Cor. 11:14)
- 2: Roaring lion (1 Peter 5:8)

Jesus' rebuke of Peter explains why Jesus told the disciples not to tell people Who He was.

☐ They were not ready to be His witnesses!

We are often blind to the strategic, "big picture" ways of God.

□Our view, our hopes, and our preferences are often way too narrow & small!

## Mark 8:34-37

Calling the crowd along with His disciples, he said to them, "If anyone wants to follow after Me, let him deny himself, take up his cross, and follow Me. 35 For whoever wants to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life because of Me and the gospel will save it. 36 For what does it benefit someone to gain the whole world and yet lose his life? 37 What can anyone give in exchange for his life? 38 For whoever is ashamed of Me and My words in this adulterous and sinful generation, the Son of Man will also be ashamed of him when he comes in the glory of his Father with the holy angels."

Good News: Jesus does not go anyway.

□God is still omnipresent (he's here), longing for us to be with Him (Follow Me!).

How Jesus is Present in this Story (and ours!) But Missed:

- 1) Jesus is the King!

- 4) He is present through discipline.
- 5) He is present through invitations to self-denial.
