Colossians 3:12a

Therefore, as God's chosen ones, holy and dearly loved ...

Colossians 3:12b-15

... <u>put on</u> compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience, ¹³ <u>bearing with one</u> <u>another</u> and forgiving one another if anyone has a grievance against another. Just as the Lord has forgiven you, so you are also to forgive. ¹⁴ <u>Above all</u>, put on love, which is the perfect bond of unity.

5 Areas:

- Social Media

- Work environment
- Home environment
- Church life

- 2) Confront unbelief and then believe—by faith—that God's way is better.

Proverbs 16:32

Patience is <u>better</u> than <u>power</u>, and controlling one's emotions (= *ruling over one's spirit*) than <u>capturing</u> a city.

a) Recognition: reactions are <u>revelations</u> to us.

b) Consideration: burden of **bad** reactions

c) Deception: I have to be in control to be happy (LIE)

God's normal requires the power of His grace.

□Not just forgiving grace but TRANSFORMING grace

3) The Gospel is the action that precedes and therefore causes my reaction.

a) Go deep into the doctrine of justification by faith in Christ.

2 Corinthians 5:21

He made the One who did not know sin to be sin <u>for us</u>, so that in Him we might become the <u>righteousness of God</u>.

Romans 4:5

But to the one who does not work, but believes on Him who <u>justifies the ungodly</u>, his faith is credited for <u>righteousness</u>.

b) Go deep into the doctrine of adoption into God's forever family.

Romans 8:14-16

For all those led by God's Spirit are God's sons. ¹⁵ For you did not receive a spirit of slavery to fall back into fear. Instead, you received the Spirit of adoption, by whom we cry out, "Abba, Father!" ¹⁶ The Spirit Himself testifies together with our spirit that we are God's children ...

Matthew 3:16-4:4

When Jesus was baptized, he went up immediately from the water. The heavens suddenly opened for him, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and coming down on him. ¹⁷ And a voice from heaven said, "This is My beloved Son, with whom I am well-pleased." **4** Then Jesus was led up by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil. ² After he had fasted forty days and forty nights, he was hungry. ³ Then the tempter approached him and said, "If you are the Son of God, tell these stones to become bread."

⁴ He answered, "It is written: *Man must not live on bread alone but on every word that comes from the mouth of God."*

I John 4:7-10 (NASB)

Beloved, let us love one another, for love is from God; and everyone who loves is born of God and knows God. ⁸ The one who does not love does not know God, for God is love. ⁹ By this the love of God was manifested in us, that God has sent His only begotten Son into the world so that we might live through Him. ¹⁰ In this is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins.
