<u>Isaiah 30:1-2</u>

They carry out a <u>plan</u>, but not Mine; they make an alliance, but against My will, piling sin on top of sin. ² Without asking My advice they set out to go down to <u>Egypt</u> in order to seek shelter under Pharaoh's protection and take refuge in Egypt's shadow.

Woe to those who go down to Egypt for help and who depend on horses! They trust in the abundance of chariots and in the large number of horsemen. They do not look to the Holy One of Israel, and they do not seek the Lord.
