### **Isaiah 30:1-2**

**Woe** to the rebellious children! This is the Lord's declaration. They carry out a **plan**, but not Mine; they make an alliance, but against My will, piling sin on top of sin.

<sup>2</sup> Without asking My advice they set out to go down to **Egypt** in order to seek shelter under Pharaoh's protection and take refuge in Egypt's shadow.

### **Isaiah 31:1**

**Woe** to those who go down to Egypt for help and who depend on horses! They **trust** in the abundance of chariots and in the large number of horsemen. They do not look to the Holy One of Israel, and they **do not seek the Lord**.

Fear the **flesh act**.

### ***Flesh Act:***

*A decision or choice driven by something other than obedience and faith*

□ Unholy fear or unholy ambition

### **Flesh Acts in Scripture:**

- Abraham nearly prostituting his wife in Egypt
- Moses killing an Egyptian in anger
- Saul consulting a witch
- Peter denying Jesus in fear

In uncertainty, we must be open to the grace of **confrontation or warning**.

and resting; your strength will lie in quiet confidence ...”

### **Isaiah 31:4-5**

For this is what the Lord said to me: “As a **lion** or young lion growls over its prey when a band of shepherds is called out against it, and it is not terrified by their shouting or subdued by their noise, so the Lord of Armies will come down to fight on Mount Zion and on its hill.

<sup>5</sup> Like **hovering birds**, so the Lord of Armies will protect Jerusalem; by protecting it, he will rescue it; by passing over it, he will deliver it.

### **Isaiah 31:9b**

This is the Lord’s declaration—whose **fire** is in Zion and whose **furnace** is in Jerusalem.

### **Isaiah 30:15-16**

For the Lord God, the Holy One of Israel, has said: “You will be delivered by returning and resting; your strength will lie in quiet confidence. But you are **not willing**.”

<sup>16</sup> You say, “No! We will escape on horses”—therefore you will escape!—and, “We will ride on fast horses”—but those who pursue you will **be faster**.”

**We are often willing to be **delivered** but not go **deeper**.**

### **Isaiah 30:18**

Therefore the Lord is **waiting** to show you mercy, and is **rising up** to show you compassion,  
for the Lord is a just God. All who **wait patiently** for Him are **happy**.

### **Psalms 130:5**

I **wait** for the Lord; I wait and put my hope **in His word**.

### **Ephesians 6:17-18**
