- My income = God's provision & blessing

## I Timothy 6:5b-6

... godliness is a way to material gain. <sup>6</sup> But godliness with contentment is great gain.

## Godliness = satisfying life and a lifestyle □ great gain >> material (\$\$) gain

#### John 10:10

A <u>thief</u> comes only to steal and kill and destroy. I have come so that they may have <u>life</u> and have it in <u>abundance</u>.

## John 3:16

#### Philippians 3:7-8, 10a

But everything that was a gain to me, I have considered to be a loss because of Christ. <sup>8</sup> More than that, I also consider everything to be a loss in view of the surpassing value of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord ... 10 My goal is to know Him ...

#### Matthew 6:19-21

"Don't store up for yourselves <u>treasures</u> on earth, where moth and rust destroy and where thieves break in and steal. <sup>20</sup> But store up for yourselves <u>treasures in heaven</u>, where neither moth nor rust destroys, and where thieves don't break in and steal. <sup>21</sup> For where your treasure is, there your <u>heart</u> will be also.

## 2 Corinthians 5:15 (NLT)

## I Timothy 6:7-10

For we brought nothing into the world, and we can take nothing out. <sup>8</sup> If we have food and clothing, we will be <u>content</u> with these. <sup>9</sup> But those who <u>want</u> to be rich fall into temptation, a trap, and many foolish and harmful desires, which plunge people into ruin and destruction. <sup>10</sup> For the love of money is <u>a root</u> of all kinds of evil, and by craving it, some have <u>wandered away</u> from the faith and pierced themselves with many griefs.

2) The love of money is a battle with love for the Lord Himself ...

#### Matthew 6:24

"No one can serve two masters, since either he will hate one and love the other, or he will be devoted to one and despise the other. You cannot serve both God and money.

## Us & Money:

- ✓ Pay & provide
- ✓ Pay & pleasure
- ✓ Give some and/or sometimes
- =Money is still a problem ... A trap!

#### <u>I Timothy 6:11-16</u>

But you, man of God, <u>flee</u> from these things, and pursue righteousness, godliness, faith, love, endurance, and gentleness. <sup>12</sup> <u>Fight</u> the good fight of the faith. <u>Take hold</u> of eternal life to which you were called and about which you have made a good confession in the presence of many witnesses. <sup>13</sup> In the presence of God, who gives life to all, and of Christ Jesus, who gave a good confession before Pontius Pilate, I charge you <sup>14</sup> to keep

this command without fault or failure until the appearing of our Lord Jesus Christ. <sup>15</sup> God will bring this about in His own time. He is the blessed and only Sovereign, the King of kings, and the Lord of lords, <sup>16</sup> who alone is immortal and who lives in unapproachable light, whom no one has seen or can see, to him be honor and eternal power. Amen.

3) Money sense (and sanity, clarity, freedom, etc.) starts with surrendering to the glory of the One greater than us.

Money: move from ownership toward surrender

□Only the Gospels brings about true surrender.

Money: financing our pleasures to funding God's purposes.

## Ephesians 4:28

If you are a thief, quit stealing. <u>Instead</u>, use your hands for good hard work, and then give generously to others in need.

God's "money" goal for His people is generosity.

Money funds the Kingdom. Money reflects the Gospel.

A true need? ☐ God provides through His church.

#### Acts 2:44-45

Now all the believers were together and held all things in common. <sup>45</sup> They sold their possessions and property and distributed the proceeds to all, as <u>any had need</u>.

Need wisdom & encouragement? ☐ God provides through His church.
