Ephesians 1:1

Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus by God's will: To the faithful <u>saints</u> in Christ Jesus <u>at</u> Ephesus.

1 Thessalonians 1:1

Paul, Silvanus, and Timothy: To the <u>church</u> of the Thessalonians <u>in</u> God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. Grace to you and peace.

God's Definition of Church: CONNECTION & LOCATION

- Connection to Christ
- No "me" but "we"
 Connection to people

Ephesians 1:20-21

He exercised this <u>power in Christ</u> by raising Him from the dead and seating Him at His right hand in the heavens—²¹ <u>far above</u> every ruler and authority, power and dominion, and every title given, not only in this age but also in the one to come. *{all together; one slide}*

- In salvation
- In power & authority

Ephesians 1:22

And *"He subjected everything under His feet"* and appointed Him as <u>head</u> over everything for the <u>church</u> ...

Ephesians 1:23

... the church, ²³ which is <u>His body</u>, the <u>fullness</u> of the One who <u>fills all things</u> in every way.

4 Things God the Father Does for God the Son:

- 1) He raises Him from the dead (v. 20)
- 2) He gives Him the seat of kingly authority (v. 20)
- 3) He put everything in the cosmos in subjection to Him (v. 21-22)
- 4) He gives Him headship over the church as His body (v. 23)

Ephesians 4:10

The One who descended is also the one who ascended far above all the heavens, to <u>fill</u> <u>all things</u>.

Ephesians 4:11-13

And He himself gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, some pastors and teachers, ¹² to equip the saints for the work of ministry, to <u>build up the body</u> of Christ, ¹³ until we all reach unity in the faith and in the knowledge of God's Son, growing into <u>maturity</u> with a stature measured by <u>Christ's fullness</u>.

Ephesians 3:10-11

This is so that God's multi-faceted wisdom may now be made known through the church to the rulers and authorities in the heavens. ¹¹ This is according to His eternal purpose accomplished in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Matthew 28:18-20

Jesus came near and said to them, "All <u>authority</u> has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. ¹⁹ Go, therefore, and make <u>disciples</u> of all nations, <u>baptizing</u> them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰ <u>teaching</u> them to observe everything I have commanded you. And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age."
