Stories Worth Sharing #4

We are <u>THIRSTY</u> people. <u>What</u> do you drink to quench your thirst? What do you drink to quench your <u>internal</u> thirst? What is best?

John 4:3–6 (CSB)

Jesus' <u>plan</u> is to help us <u>see</u> our internal thirst in order to <u>seek</u> the only water that satisfies.

Need \rightarrow seek water = quench thirst

John 4:7–15 (CSB)

Jesus' <u>plan</u> was to help an impure/ignorant/lost person <u>see</u> her interior thirst in order to ...

¹⁰ Jesus answered, "*If you knew* the **gift of God**, and **who** is saying to you, 'Give me a drink,' *you would ask him*, and *he would give you* **living water**."

... in order to ask & receive water that only God can give.

¹¹ "Sir," said the woman, "you don't even have a bucket, and the well is deep. So **where** do you get this '**living water**'? ¹² You aren't greater than our father **Jacob**, are you? He gave us the well and drank from it himself, as did his sons and livestock."

We may still <u>misunderstand</u> who Jesus is and the water only He gives: teacher & fresh water

¹³ Jesus said, "Everyone who drinks from **this water** will get **thirsty again**. ¹⁴ But whoever drinks from the **water that I will give** him will **never get thirsty again**. In fact, the water **I will give** him will **become a well of water springing up in him** for eternal life." ¹⁵ "Sir," the woman said to him, "<u>give me</u> *this water* so that I won't get thirsty and come **here** to draw water."

Jesus teaches us the superiority of His water and we may want it, but we may think it is common water: comfort, possessions, fame.

What is this living water? & How do we receive it?

John 4:16–26 (CSB)

1) <u>Recognize</u> your sin and the fact that people (idols?) can not quench your internal thirst!

What is your sin?

What water are you drinking? (Idols)

¹⁹ "Sir," the woman replied, "I see that **you are a prophet**. ²⁰ **Our ancestors** worshiped on *this mountain*, but you **Jews** say that the *place to worship* is in

Jerusalem." ²¹ Jesus told her, "**Believe me**, woman, an hour is coming when you will worship the Father *neither on this mountain nor in Jerusalem*. ²² You **Samaritans** worship what you do not know. We worship what we do know, because salvation is from the Jews. ²³ But **an hour** is coming, and is now **here**, when the true worshipers *will worship the Father* **in Spirit and in truth**. Yes, the Father wants such people to worship him. ²⁴ **God is spirit**, and those who worship him must worship **in Spirit and in truth**."

2) Do not learn theology just to chat it, but to believe it and live it.

John 7:38–39 (CSB)

The one who **believes in me**, as the Scripture has said, **will have streams of living water flow from deep within him**." ³⁹ He said this about the **Spirit**. Those who **believed** in Jesus were going to **receive** the Spirit, for the Spirit had not yet been given because Jesus had not yet been glorified [resurrected].

3) Do not <u>minimize</u> (downplay) Jesus, but <u>believe</u> He is the Messiah (King).

²⁵ The woman said to him, "I know that the **Messiah** is coming" (who is called Christ). "When he comes, **he will explain** everything to us." ²⁶ Jesus told her, "I, the one speaking to you, **am he**."

John 4:27–30 (CSB)

Just then his disciples arrived, and they were amazed that he was talking with a woman. Yet no one said, "What do you want?" or "Why are you talking with her?" ²⁸ Then the woman **left her water jar**, went into town, and told the people, ²⁹ "Come, see a man who told me everything I ever did. **Could this be the Messiah**?" ³⁰ **They** left the town and made their way to him.

Faith in Jesus (God/human) moves us!

John 4:39–42 (CSB)

Now **many Samaritans** from that town **believed** in him because of what the *woman* said when she testified, "He told me everything I ever did." ⁴⁰ So when the Samaritans came to him, they asked him to stay with them, and he stayed there two days. ⁴¹ **Many more believed** because of what he said. ⁴² And they told the woman, "We no longer believe because of what you said, since we have heard for ourselves and know that this really is the **Savior of the world**."

1) <u>Believe in Jesus</u> for who he is: God in the flesh, Messiah (King), Savior of the world.

2) Ask and receive His living water.

3) <u>Keep drinking the living water!</u> (<u>1 Cor 12.13</u>)
