You should totally take that extra piece of candy. No one will notice. Besides, you deserve it. You've worked so hard this week. What's the big deal?

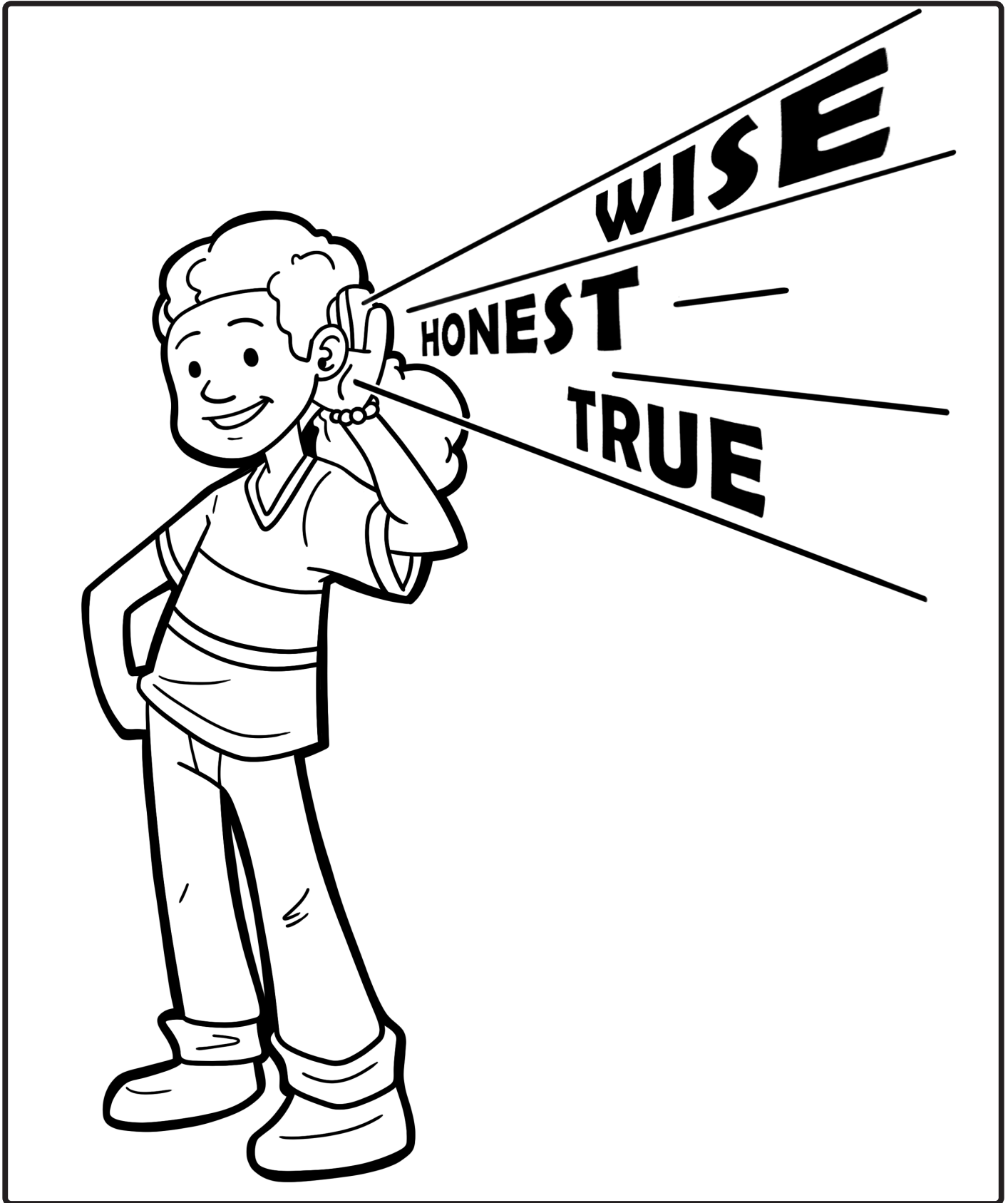
