2 Major Dangers:

- Distancing from God
- Bringing to God only what is "presentable"

I Peter 1:22b-25

... so that you show sincere brotherly love for each other, from a pure heart <u>love one</u> <u>another constantly</u>, ²³ because you have been <u>born again</u>—not of perishable seed but of imperishable—through <u>the living and enduring word of God.</u>²⁴ For *All flesh is like grass, and all its glory like a flower of the grass. The grass withers, and the flower falls,* ²⁵ *but the word of the Lord endures forever.* And this word is the <u>gospel</u> that was proclaimed to you.

<u>John 6:63</u>

The <u>Spirit</u> is the One who gives <u>life</u> … The words that I have spoken to you are <u>spirit</u> and are life.

Genesis 1:1-2

In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. ² Now the earth was formless and empty, darkness covered the surface of the watery depths, and the <u>Spirit of God</u> was <u>hovering</u> over the surface of the waters.

Creation is the start of a love story where's God love is the source of all things.

People—as image bearers—created from God's love and for His love.

However, we spurned (doubted □ deceived) God's love in favor what was perceived to be freedom and better happiness.

Romans 5:5b

For we know how dearly God loves us, because He has given us the <u>Holy Spirit to fill</u> our hearts with His love.

Romans 5:8

But God proves His own love for us in that while we were <u>still sinners</u>, Christ died for us. (=*I Peter 1:25 – "…this word is the gospel that was proclaimed to you."*)

We only and fully come to God's love <u>through the Cross</u> ... which means we come with our <u>sins, failures, traumas, disappointments, and weaknesses</u>.

□We come vulnerable to receive & experience the unconditional love of God!!

"Even in sin, you are loving me ... you can only love and accept who I as I actually am And so, even in sin—which You hate and died for—You are loving me (versus leaving me), which ironically, makes me so much more inclined to kill sin by Your Spirit and please You by obedience!"

I Peter 2:1

Therefore, rid yourselves of all malice, all deceit, hypocrisy, envy, and all slander.

{These can be on 5 different slides for better/easier viewing}

- Malice: a desire to hurt someone verbally, physically, or circumstantially
- Deceit: a desire to gain/preserve an advantage through dishonesty
- **Hypocrisy**: maintaining an appearance, afraid of people's reaction if they knew the real me
- Envy: a desire for something and resentment toward someone who has it
- Slander: a desire for self-enhancement by putting someone else down

Colossians 3:11-13

In Christ there is not Greek and Jew, circumcision and uncircumcision, barbarian, Scythian, slave and free; but <u>Christ is all and in all</u>. ¹² Therefore, as God's chosen ones, holy and <u>dearly loved</u>, put on compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience, ¹³ bearing with one another and forgiving one another ...

I Peter 2:4-6

<u>As you come to Him</u>, a living stone—rejected by people but chosen and honored by God— ⁵ you yourselves, as living stones, a spiritual house, are <u>being built</u> to be a holy priesthood to offer spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ. ⁶ For it stands in Scripture:

See, I lay a stone in Zion, a chosen and honored cornerstone, and the one who believes in Him will <u>never be put to shame</u>.

The scary and awesome part of perfect love: it invites complete surrender.

I Peter 2:7-8

So <u>honor</u> will come to you who believe; but for the unbelieving, *The stone that the builders rejected—this one has become the cornerstone, ⁸ and a stone to stumble over, and a rock to trip over.* They stumble because they <u>disobey the word</u>; they were destined for this.

I Peter 2:9-10

But you are a <u>chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for His</u> <u>possession</u>, so that you may <u>proclaim the praises of the One</u> who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light. ¹⁰ Once you were not a people, but now <u>you are</u> <u>God's people</u>; you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy.
