System of Belief:

To be successful and happy, it's up to me and I have to try hard to make "it" happen; therefore, I need to be in control.

Fear and anxiety are often connected to beliefs about control.

I Peter 4:1-2

Therefore, since Christ suffered in the flesh, <u>arm yourselves</u> also with the same understanding—because the one who suffers in the flesh is finished with sin— ² in order to live the remaining time in the flesh <u>no longer for human desires</u>, but for <u>God's will</u>.

John 6:29 (NLT)

Jesus told them, "This is the <u>only work</u> God wants from you: <u>Believe</u> in the One He has sent."

I Peter 4:3-4

For there has already been enough time spent in doing what the Gentiles choose to do: carrying on in unrestrained behavior, evil desires, drunkenness, orgies, carousing, and lawless idolatry. ⁴ They are surprised that you don't join them in the same flood of wild living—and they slander you.

Typical Question:

Am I trusting God with/in THIS?

Psalm 16:5-9

Lord, you are my portion and my cup of blessing; you hold my future.

⁶ The boundary lines have fallen for me in pleasant places; indeed, I have a beautiful inheritance. ⁷ I will bless the Lord who counsels me—even at night when my thoughts trouble me. ⁸ I always let the Lord guide me. Because He is at my right hand, I will not be shaken. ⁹ Therefore my heart is glad and my whole being rejoices; my body also rests securely.

Christ-followers are DIFFERENT because they have God; therefore, they <u>abandon</u> <u>outcomes and results</u> to Him.

I Peter 4:5-6

They will give an account to the one who stands ready to <u>judge</u> the living and the dead. ⁶ For this reason the gospel was also preached to those who are now dead, so that, although they might be <u>judged in the flesh according to human standards</u>, they might <u>live in the spirit</u> according to God's standards.

1) Be different: no more energy seeking <u>validation</u>, <u>vindication</u>, <u>or approval</u> from people!

I Peter 4:7

The end of all things is near; therefore, be alert and sober-minded for prayer.

2) Be different: we know the <u>goal</u>, we have the <u>prize</u>, so pray for His <u>will to be</u> done.

I Peter 4:8-9

Above all, maintain constant love for one another, since *love covers a multitude of sins*. ⁹ Be hospitable to one another without complaining.

3) Be different: no more energy trying to <u>"fix" others</u> and <u>complaining</u> about life and the people in it.

I Peter 4:10-11

Just as each one has received a gift, use it to <u>serve others</u>, as <u>good stewards</u> of the varied grace of God. ¹¹ If anyone speaks, let it be as one who speaks God's words; if anyone serves, let it be from the strength <u>God provides</u>, so that <u>God may be glorified</u> through Jesus Christ in everything. To Him be the glory and the power forever and ever. Amen.

4) Be different: no more <u>self-promotion or self-exaltation</u>; live for Him and from the graces He provides to do as much good as possible.

I Peter 4:12-16

Dear friends, don't be surprised when the fiery ordeal comes among you to test you, as if something unusual were happening to you. ¹³ Instead, rejoice as you share in the sufferings of Christ, so that you may also rejoice with great joy when His glory is

revealed. ¹⁴ If you are ridiculed for the name of Christ, you are <u>blessed</u>, because the Spirit of glory and of God rests on you. ¹⁵ Let none of you suffer as a murderer, a thief, an evildoer, or a meddler. ¹⁶ But if anyone suffers as a Christian, let him not be ashamed but let him glorify God in having that name.

- 5) Be different: rejoice in the ordeals
 - Not being in control does not mean we become irresponsible or sinful
 - We do our best, but we do not trust our best.

I Peter 4:17, 19

For the time has come for judgment to begin with God's household, and if it begins with us, what will the outcome be for those who disobey the gospel of God? ... ¹⁹ So then, let those who suffer according to God's will entrust themselves to a faithful Creator while doing what is good.

Be different: don't live in the <u>lie of control</u>; live <u>entrusted</u> to the One who died for us all!
