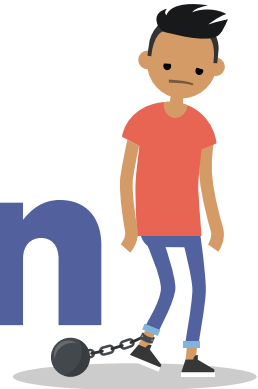
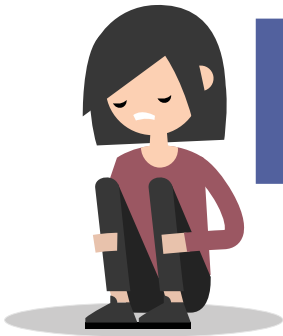

WHAT WE ARE LEARNING:



Broken by Sin



BROKEN—

Something that has been torn or fragmented

When people sin, they break the relationship they had with God. They are separated from God by their sin. The good news is that God's plan provides the answer to the brokenness caused by sin.



KNOW

Sin is to think, say, or behave in any way that goes against God and His commands.



UNDERSTAND

All people are broken by sin.



DISCOVER

Before trusting Jesus, our identity is broken by our sin and rebellion against God.

ADAM AND EVE SINNED

One day a serpent approached Eve and asked, “Did God really say, ‘You can’t eat from any tree in the garden?’”

Eve corrected the serpent: “We may eat fruit from any tree except one in the middle of the garden. God said, ‘You must not touch or eat that fruit, or you will die.’”

The serpent told Eve, “You won’t die! In fact, God knows that when you eat it, you will be like Him, knowing good and evil.”

Eve looked at the fruit on the tree. She remembered that the serpent said the fruit would make her wise. Eve took some of the fruit and ate it. She gave some to Adam, and he ate it, too.

Immediately, Adam and Eve realized what they had done. They tried to cover themselves and hide from God.

That evening, God called out to Adam. “Where are you? Did you eat from the tree I commanded you not to?”

Eve said, “The serpent tricked me, and I ate it.”

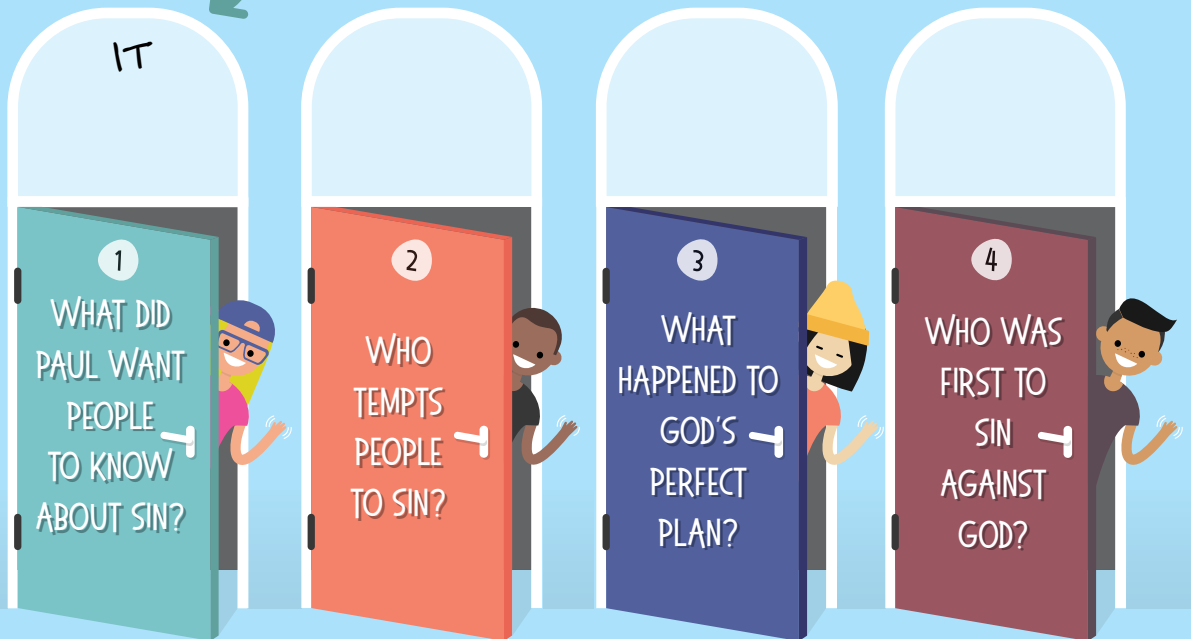
God told the serpent, “Because you have done this, you are cursed more than any other animal. You will move on your belly and eat dust.” Then God told Eve, “You will have pain when you have a baby.” God told Adam, “You must work hard to grow your food now, and one day you will die.”
