How do we determine if something is a "good deal"?

- Cost → \$\$, convenience, commitment
- Value → personal, social, cultural worth

Invitations from Jesus:

- Come to Me: learn, be yoked ... gentle & humble in heart
- Come to Me: drink ... \rightarrow refreshed by being with Jesus
- ullet Forgive ... as God has forgiven ... ightarrow unyoked from unforgiveness
- Believe ... do greater works ... → Serve
- Heart follows treasure ... Kingdom investor → Give \$\$
- Witness ... \rightarrow Go share and show the King & His Kingdom

<u>Luke 9 Invitation</u> → Clarity about the "deal" Jesus is offering ...

- 1) Promote deep **consideration** (vs. superficial acceptance or rejection)
- 2) Prompt either enduring commitment OR clear rejection

Luke 9:18-20a

While He was praying in private and His <u>disciples</u> were with Him, He asked them, "Who do <u>the crowds</u> say that I am?" ¹⁹ They answered, "John the Baptist; others, Elijah; still others, that one of the ancient prophets has come back." ²⁰ "But you," He asked them, "who do you say that I am?"

Luke 9:20b-22

... Peter answered, "God's Messiah." ²¹ But He strictly warned and instructed them to tell this to no one, ²² saying, "It is necessary that the Son of Man suffer many things and be rejected by the elders, chief priests, and scribes, <u>be killed</u>, and <u>be raised</u> the third day."

<u>Living the Red Letter Life</u> = Life with God as part of His Kingdom

- Invitation to build my life on Jesus and His Words
 - o Available to all through trust & reliance \rightarrow joyful obedience
 - o Abundance: rest for your souls, rivers of living water vs. ill-fitting vokes
- Confidence in the identity of Jesus → God's Messiah
- Luke 9:23

Accurate and confident understanding of Jesus is essential ... but NOT all that is needed to live the "Red Letter" life ...

Luke 9:23

Then He said to them all, "If <u>anyone</u> wants to follow after Me, let him <u>deny himself</u>, <u>take</u> <u>up his cross daily</u>, and <u>follow Me</u>.

Cross-Bearing:

- Way of life → Jesus is not a hobby or side-interest
- Complete submission; captivated by life with Jesus

Self-Denying:

- Self that acts in apparent self-interest
- Self that trusts its ability, its wisdom and its desires
- Self as the ultimate frame of reference

The "self" that Jesus invites us to deny:

- Yokes itself to the wrong things
- Causes problems
- Grows weary & thirsty

Psalm 145:1-3

I exalt you, my God the King, and bless your name forever and ever.

Cross-Bearing + Self-Denying

= the full and yet daily surrender of a lesser, dying, problem-causing self for a greater, eternal one \rightarrow

the person God envisioned in creation, died for in redemption, and purposed for in His Kingdom

Colossians 3:10 (J.B. Philipps)

... you have finished with the old man and all he did and have begun life as the new man, who is out to learn what he ought to be, according to the plan of God.

²I will bless you every day; I will praise your name forever and ever.

³ The Lord is great and is highly praised; His greatness is unsearchable.

2 Primary Obstacles:

- Vision (& information) without intention → take up Cross daily
- Sensitivity to self (aka the old self) → deny self

Luke 9:24-26

For whoever wants to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life because of Me will save it. ²⁵ For what does it benefit someone if he gains the whole world, and yet loses or forfeits himself? For whoever is ashamed of Me and My words, the Son of Man will be ashamed of him when He comes ...

The soul is an investor and a profit-seeker.

True rest, joy, satisfaction and life cannot be found without discipleship to Jesus.

The only real "deal" in life is to <u>surrender</u> ourselves to Jesus and His will as revealed through <u>His Words</u>.

- 1) Decisively decide to become a devoted disciple of Jesus.
 - → Biblical Baptism-?

Romans 6:3-5 (MSG)

... what happened in <u>baptism</u>. When we went under the water, we left the old country of sin behind; when we came up out of the water, we entered into the new country of grace—a new life in a new land!

That's what baptism into the life of Jesus means. When we are lowered into the water, it is like the burial of Jesus; when we are raised up out of the water, it is like the resurrection of Jesus. Each of us is raised into a light-filled world by our Father ...
