Matthew 4:17

From then on Jesus began to preach, "Repent, because the <u>kingdom of heaven</u> has come near."

- In Matthew: Kingdom x54; church: x3
- 1) The Kingdom of Jesus is ultimately important.
 - → Worldly politics is made relative by and subordinate to Jesus' Kingdom.

Knowing what is ultimately important changes how anxious, triumphalist or despondent we are about the outcome of each election cycle.

When we make ultimate something of lesser importance, we'll sin to protect or promote it.

- We HAVE to WIN the debate, the argument, the election!
- We're justified in getting so upset and so angry at ______.
- We have to TAKE A STAND!

Matthew 5:1-11

When He saw the crowds, He went up on the mountain, and after He sat down, His disciples came to Him. ² Then He began to teach them, saying:

- ³ "Blessed are the poor in spirit, for the kingdom of heaven is theirs.
- ⁴ Blessed are those who mourn, for they will be comforted.
- ⁵Blessed are the humble, for they will inherit the earth.
- ⁶ Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they will be filled.
- ⁷Blessed are the merciful, for they will be shown mercy.
- ⁸ Blessed are the pure in heart, for they will see God.
- ⁹ Blessed are the peacemakers, for they will be called sons of God.
- ¹⁰ Blessed are those who are persecuted because of righteousness, for the kingdom of heaven is theirs.
- ¹¹ "You are blessed when they insult you and persecute you and falsely say every kind of evil against you because of me. ¹² Be <u>glad and rejoice</u>, because your reward is great in heaven …

The Beatitudes are not conditions of the Kingdom.

☐ The Beatitudes articulate the <u>radical inclusivity</u>, <u>amazing availability</u>, and <u>overflowing abundant goodness</u> of the Kingdom.

Matthew 5:13a-16

"You are the <u>salt of the earth</u> ... ¹⁴ "You are the <u>light of the world</u>. A city situated on a hill cannot be hidden. ¹⁵ No one lights a lamp and puts it under a basket, but rather on a lampstand, and it gives light for all who are in the house. ¹⁶ In the same way, let your light shine <u>before others</u>, so that they may see <u>your good works</u> and give <u>glory to your Father</u> in heaven.

 - a) We rest and rejoice in the sovereignty of God.

Daniel 2:21a (NLT)

He controls the course of world events; He removes kings and sets up other kings.

b) We know how the Kingdom advances: sacrificial love.

John 18:36 (NLT)

Jesus answered, "My Kingdom is <u>not</u> an earthly kingdom. If it were, My followers would fight to keep me from being handed over to the Jewish leaders. But My Kingdom is not <u>of</u> this world."
