Matthew 6:8b-10 (NASB)

... your Father knows what you need before you ask Him. ⁹ "<u>Pray</u>, then, in this way: 'Our Father Who is in heaven, Hallowed be Your name. ¹⁰ 'Your kingdom come. Your will be done, On earth as it is in heaven ..."

Jesus taught that there is a <u>connection</u> between God's <u>rule and renown</u> and our <mark>prayers</mark>.

Romans 15:25-29

Right now I am traveling to Jerusalem to <u>serve the saints</u>, ²⁶ because Macedonia and Achaia were pleased to make a <u>contribution for the poor</u> among the saints in Jerusalem. ²⁷ Yes, they were pleased, and indeed are indebted to them. For if the Gentiles have shared in their spiritual benefits, then they are obligated to minister to them in material needs. ²⁸ So when I have finished this and <u>safely delivered the funds</u> to them, I will <u>visit you</u> on the way to Spain. ²⁹ I know that when I come to you, I will come in the fullness of the blessing of Christ.

Romans 15:30

Now I appeal to you, brothers and sisters, <u>through our Lord</u> Jesus Christ and <u>through</u> <u>the love of the Spirit</u>, to <u>strive</u> together with me <u>in prayers</u> to God on my behalf.

Paul asks for <u>intercessory prayer</u>. ("strive ... with me ... on my behalf") \rightarrow WHY?

{one slide for point #1}

1) Intercessory prayer invokes the <u>authority</u> of Jesus and therefore, releases His favor and power.

• The prayers of the Roman church can affect a situation 1300 miles away!

2) Intercessory prayer is a way of **loving others** deeply and powerfully.

Intercessory prayer is a profound invitation.

- a) To leave the endless spiral of "self" ...
- b) To return to our place of purpose ...

$\textbf{CREATION} \rightarrow \textbf{made in the image of God}$

Genesis 1:27-28 (NLT)

So God created human beings in <u>His own image</u>. In the image of God he created them; male and female He created them. ²⁸ Then God blessed them and said, "Be fruitful and multiply. Fill the earth and <u>govern</u> it. <u>Reign</u> …

Psalm 115:1 (NLT)

Not to us, O Lord, not to us, but to Your name goes all the glory for Your unfailing love and faithfulness.

Psalm 115:16 (MSG)

The heaven of heavens is for God, but He put us in charge of the earth.

FALL (sin + evil) \rightarrow Deceived, now damaged & dangerous

Genesis 3:23 (MSG)

God expelled them from the Garden of Eden ...

John 12:31 (NLT)

The time for judging this world has come, when <u>Satan</u>, the <u>ruler of this world</u>, will be cast out.

PROMISE \rightarrow Hope!!

<u>Isaiah 9:6-7</u>

For a <u>child</u> will be born for us, a son will be given to us, and the <u>government</u> will be on his shoulders. He will be named Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace. ⁷ The <u>dominion</u> will be vast …

JESUS \rightarrow His reign is here, now, and forever!

Matthew 28:16

Jesus came near and said to them, "All <u>authority</u> has been given to Me in heaven and on earth.

John 16:23-24 (MSG)

"This is what I want you to do: <u>Ask</u> the Father for whatever is in keeping with the things I've <u>revealed</u> to you. <u>Ask in My Name</u>, according to <u>My will</u>, and He'll most certainly give it to you. Your joy will be a river overflowing its banks!

Under God, the prayers of His people <u>run the world</u>.

• God has chosen to make prayer indispensable!

Our great hope in prayer is not to change what God has planned, but <u>to bring</u> <mark>about</mark> what He has planned.

The blessing & dignity of participation & partnership \rightarrow significance!

What happens when people *really* pray?

Romans 15:31-32

Pray that I may be <u>rescued</u> from the unbelievers in Judea, that my ministry to Jerusalem may be <u>acceptable</u> to the saints, ³² and that, <u>by God's will</u>, I may <u>come to</u> <u>you</u> with joy</u> and be <u>refreshed</u> together with you. May the God of peace <u>be with</u> all of you. Amen.

Paul's Belief About Intercessory Prayer:

- God can remove <u>obstacles</u> so that His <u>love</u> can be known & His <u>will</u> be done
 - o On the ground: Elders; Roman commander; Paul's nephew ...
 - In the "air": prayers of the Roman church!

Luke 2:36-38 (JB Ph)

There was also present, Anna ... who was a prophetess. She was a very old woman, having had seven years' married life and was now a widow of eighty-four. She spent her whole life in the Temple and worshipped God night and day with <u>fastings and prayers</u>. She came up at this very moment, praised God and spoke about Jesus to all those in Jerusalem who were expecting redemption.

God's will will be done whether we pray or not, but <mark>His will</mark> will not be done without prayer.

- \rightarrow Made to rule
- \rightarrow Saved from sin to rule with Jesus Christ
