Everyone trades for joy.

Luke 1:26-29

In the sixth month, the angel Gabriel was sent by God to a town in Galilee called Nazareth, ²⁷ to a virgin engaged to a man named Joseph, of the house of David. The virgin's name was Mary. ²⁸ And the angel came to her and said, "Greetings, favored woman! The Lord is with you." ²⁹ But she was deeply troubled by this statement, wondering what kind of greeting this could be.

The foundational lie: God is a killjoy.

The foundational truth: God is for the joy of all people.

Luke 1:30-33

How We Pursue Joy:

- Control
- Striving
- Escape/Relief

Mary said: "My soul magnifies the Lord, ⁴⁷ and my spirit rejoices in God my Savior, ⁴⁸ because He has looked with favor on the humble condition of His servant.
