They have grown and produced fruit. You are ever on their lips, but far from their conscience. ³ As for you, Lord, you know me; you see me. You test whether my heart is with you ...

Jeremiah 1:1-2

The words of Jeremiah, the son of Hilkiah, one of the priests living in Anathoth in the territory of Benjamin. ² The word of the Lord came to him in the thirteenth year of the reign of Josiah son of Amon, king of Judah.

Jeremiah 1:4-5

The word of the Lord came to me: ⁵ <u>I chose you</u> before I formed you in the womb; <u>I set you apart</u> before you were born. <u>I appointed you</u> a prophet to the nations.

God <u>CHOSE</u> God <u>SET APART</u> God <u>APPOINTED</u> (~given)

{all together one slide}
The starting point is God, not self ...
I do not have to search, but come ...
I do not have to make the first move ...

\rightarrow I am appointed to move in the direction of being a giver.

Jeremiah 1:6 But I protested, "Oh no, Lord God! Look, I don't know how to speak since I am only a youth."

We have convinced ourselves that we cannot and should not race against the horses and that somehow God understands.

Jeremiah 1:7-8

Then the Lord said to me: <u>Do not say</u>, "I am only a youth," for you will go to everyone I send you to and speak whatever I tell you. ⁸<u>Do not be afraid</u> of anyone, for I will be with you to rescue you. This is the Lord's declaration.

1) Stop any <u>self-talk</u> that does not align with God's words.

2) Do not let <u>fear win within</u>.

Jeremiah 1:17-19

"<u>Now, get ready.</u> Stand up ... Do not be intimidated... ¹⁸ Today, I am the one who has made you a fortified city, an iron pillar ... I am with you to rescue you." This is the Lord's declaration.
