Jeremiah 25:1-2

This is the <u>word that came to</u> Jeremiah concerning all the people of Judah in the fourth year of Jehoiakim son of Josiah, king of Judah (which was the first year of King Nebuchadnezzar of Babylon). ²The prophet Jeremiah spoke concerning all the people of Judah and all the residents of Jerusalem as follows ...

Jeremiah 25:3

"From the thirteenth year of Josiah son of Amon, king of Judah, until this very day—<u>twenty-three years</u>—the word of the Lord has come to me, and I have spoken to you <u>time and time again</u>, but you have not obeyed.

{one slide; all together}

Key Phrase: "time and again" for 23 years

- x11 times
- = to rise early ... to start early

Jeremiah 1:4-5

The word of the Lord came to me: ⁵I <u>chose you</u> before I formed you in the womb; I <u>set you apart</u> before you were born. I <u>appointed you</u> a prophet to the nations.

God gave Jeremiah a <u>future</u> and he <u>stuck</u> with it.

 \rightarrow <u>Persistence</u> in our God-appointed <u>purpose</u>.

2 Part Purpose:

1) Live in a <u>special</u> (personal & community) relationship with <u>God</u> (*love God*)

<u>Acts 17:28a</u>

For in Him we live and move and have our being ...

2) Do good for the glory of God (*love others, live sent*)

Ephesians 2:10

For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus <u>for good works</u>, which God prepared <u>ahead of time</u> for us to do.

{bullet points come up one at a time; same slide}

Doing Good:

- Spontaneous vs. Steadfast
- Gets our best energy & focus
- Flows from "being"
- Conviction over convenience & comfort

Cultivating Persistence in Purpose:

1) By faith, believe in the <u>maximum</u> of "life in Christ."

<u>Titus 3:14</u>

Let our people learn to devote themselves to good works for pressing needs, so that they will not be <u>unfruitful</u>.

Acts 20:24 (NLT)

But my life is worth nothing to me <u>unless</u> I use it for finishing the work <u>assigned</u> me by the Lord Jesus—the work of telling others the Good News about the wonderful grace of God.

2) Quickly recognize and say "No" to "less than" living

{one slide but bullets come up one at a time} **Say No:**

- To triviality
- To emotional fragility

- To complacency
- To drift
- To toxic emotions

3) Know and stay vitally connected to the <u>Source = God</u>!

Insufficient Sources:

- a) This life (or horizontal) sources
- b) Within ourselves
- c) Dutiful vs. Delightful faith

Jeremiah: *"time and again" = rose early ... start early*

Lamentations 3:21-23

This I recall to my mind, Therefore I have hope.

²² The Lord's loving kindnesses indeed never cease, For His compassions never fail.
²³ They are new every morning; Great is Your faithfulness.

Life and the "race" guarantee we will be poured out. How will we be "filled" up?

Ephesians 3:19 (JB Ph)

May you be filled though all your being with God himself!
