2 Corinthians 13:13

The grace of the <mark>Lord Jesus Christ</mark>, and the love of <mark>God</mark>, and the fellowship of the <mark>Holy Spirit</mark> be with you <mark>all</mark>.

Paul wanted the Corinthian Christians to be completely blessed by all of Who God is.

WHO GOD IS \rightarrow

- <u>Attributes</u>
- Identity: Triune; Trinity; Three in One
 - \circ One God: in essence, in being
 - Unfolds into three interpersonal relationships
 - Same attributes = God = Always God
 - Distinct & Harmonious Roles

Uncreated Fellowship of God (Father, Son, Spirit)

1) Realization: this redefines how we think of the Christian life.

What is the "Christian" life?

- Beliefs
- Behavior

When we think of the Christian life, we need to think more about $\frac{\text{WHO than WHAT}}{\text{HO of at the center.}}$.

2) Realization: the crucial role of the <mark>Holy Spirit</mark> in making this life (this blessing) a <u>reality</u> to us.

Why does Paul use "fellowship of the Holy Spirit"?

John 14:16-18

I will ask the Father, and He will give you <mark>another Counselor</mark> to be with you forever. ¹⁷ He is the <mark>Spirit of truth</mark> ... you do know Him, because He remains with you and will be in you. ¹⁸ "I will not leave you as <u>orphans</u>; I am coming to you.

God the Father <mark>plans</mark> God the Son <mark>accomplishes</mark>

God the Spirit applies

Holy Spirit:

- personal with us and interpersonal with Father & Son
- closes the "space-time" gap so we can know God

<u>Romans 8:9</u>

You, however, are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if indeed the Spirit of God lives in you. If anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he does not belong to Him.

3) Realization: what the availability of this fellowship to all means.

<u>John 16:7</u>

... It is for your <mark>benefit</mark> that I go away, because if I don't go away the Counselor will not come to you. If I go, I will <mark>send Him</mark> to you.

Acts 2:33

... since He has been <mark>exalted</mark> to the right hand of God and has <mark>received</mark> from the Father the <mark>promised</mark> Holy Spirit, He has <mark>poured out</mark> what <mark>you</mark> both see and hear.

<u>Psalm 2:8</u>

Ask of Me, and I will make <u>the nations</u> Your inheritance and the ends of the earth your possession.

a) The <mark>coronation</mark> of God the Son

b) A promise fulfilled between Father & Son

Holy Spirit in the Old Testament:

- Selectively
- Ethnically
- Geographically

c) A dawning of a new era and new reality $\rightarrow \frac{\text{all can know Him}}{\text{all can know Him}}$!

<u>Amos 3:7</u>

Indeed, the Lord God does nothing without revealing His counsel to His <mark>servants the</mark> prophets.

Acts 2:17-18

'<mark>In the last days</mark>,' God says, 'I will pour out my Spirit upon <mark>all</mark> people. Your sons and daughters will prophesy. Your young men will see visions, and your old men will dream

dreams. ¹⁸ In those days I will pour out my Spirit <u>even on</u> my servants—men and women alike—and they will prophesy.

<u>Jeremiah 31:33, 34</u>

... this is the covenant I will make with the house of Israel after those days"—the Lord's declaration. "I will put my teaching <u>within them</u> and write it on their <u>hearts</u>. I will be their God, and they will be My people. ³⁴ No longer will one teach his neighbor or his brother, saying, 'Know the Lord,' for they will <u>all know Me</u>, from the least to the greatest of them" ...

Acts 2:4-11 (JB Ph.)

They were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in different languages as the Spirit gave them power to proclaim His message.

⁵⁻¹¹Now there were staying in Jerusalem Jews from every nation of the world. When they heard this sound a crowd quickly collected and were completely bewildered because each one of them heard these men speaking in <u>his own language</u> ... Then how does it happen that every single one of us can hear the particular language he has known from a child? ... There are Jews and proselytes, men from Crete and men from Arabia, yet we can all hear these men speaking of the <u>magnificence of God</u> in our <u>native</u> language."

I John 2:20

... you have been anointed by the Holy One, and you all have knowledge.

Do we realize what "age" we are living in??!??!?

4) Realization: We do not so much as make <mark>decisions</mark> for Christ; we are <mark>miracles</mark> of God the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit.

2 Corinthians 13:13

The grace of the <mark>Lord Jesus Christ</mark>, and the love of <mark>God</mark>, and the fellowship of the <mark>Holy Spirit</mark> be with you <mark>all</mark>.

{one at a time; can be different slides}

- Ask God to help you realize it's never up to you nor about you but it does include you!
- Ask God to give you a sense of this unfathomable privilege.
- Ask God to make His presence the controlling reality of your life.
- Ask God to help your unbelief, give you faith and then act the miracle that you are!
