Why do you "go" to church ...??

## **Ephesians 2:17-22**

He came and proclaimed the good news of peace to you who were far away and peace to those who were near. <sup>18</sup> For through Him we both have access in one Spirit to the Father. <sup>19</sup> So, then, you are no longer foreigners and strangers, but fellow citizens with the saints, and members of God's household, <sup>20</sup> built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, with Christ Jesus Himself as the cornerstone. <sup>21</sup> In Him the whole building, being put together, grows into a holy temple in the Lord. <sup>22</sup> In Him you are also being built together for God's dwelling in the Spirit.

## **Key Points:**

- God is building a community (WE) → church
- We all want an identity, to belong, and to have access
- We also are pretty big "me" people → conflict

The church is the epicenter of God's presence, activity and purpose. (actualized by the Holy Spirit)

Relate to the church at level of personal convenience/inconvenience

OR

the level of **holy conviction**.

1) The Holy Spirit's work culminates and apexes in the church.

The Gospel does not merely save individuals. The Holy Spirit does not isolate individuals. Jesus is not just my personal Lord & Savior.

- b) Our emotional narcissism can cause us to use methods to "produce" the desired result that are not of the Spirit.

3) God defines the church by the truth and by His presence; therefore, we should settle for nothing less!
