Families, use this to prompt conversations at the table, in the car, and anywhere else your family experiences life together.

- Let's make a list of all the people who love us! How do we know they love us?
- Jesus loves you! That means you are loved no matter what. What are some ways Jesus shows us He loves us?
- What things can we do to show Jesus that we love Him?
- How can we let other people know that Jesus loves them too?





Gather red construction or printer paper (if you don't have red, white is fine too!). Work together to cut out a paper heart for each member of the family. Write "Jesus loves [name of a family member]" on each heart. Each person can draw a simple picture of himself on the heart, or you can cut out photos of each person and glue them on the hearts. Hang the hearts up somewhere everyone will see them each day (on a bathroom mirror, kitchen window, or wherever works best) to remember how loved each person is!





Bake It and Take It

As a family, show Jesus' love in a practical way—by making treats! Come up with a list of friends or neighbors who you'd like to share the love of Jesus with. Who in your life might not yet know that Jesus loves them or have experienced His love personally? Bake or make treats for the people on your list. (Store-bought treats in gift bags work too!) Create notes that say, "Jesus loves you, and so do we!" Consider including information about the service times of your church or an invitation to an upcoming church event.

When you deliver the treats, watch for opportunities to engage in conversation. Look for ways to build relationships with those around you, and if you get the chance, invite them to church. (This is a great chance for your kids to practice their conversation skills and work on manners too!)

When you return home from making the deliveries, pray for each person and talk together about other ways your family can share Jesus' love with them.
