Presence of the King == Arrival & Availability of the Kingdom life

Repent:

change of thinking → living BECAUSE of the immediate availability of the Kingdom

→ A REALITY that must be RESPONDED to ...

Moving into the Sermon on the Mount // Moving into the Kingdom

1) The **Call** of Jesus the King

The nature of the call (Who & what) forces a response (~ranking).

Matthew 4:18-22

As He was walking along the Sea of Galilee, he saw two brothers, Simon (who is called Peter), and his brother Andrew. They were casting a net into the sea—for they were fishermen. ¹⁹ "Follow Me," He told them, "and I will make you fish for people." ²⁰ Immediately they left their nets and followed Him. ²¹ Going on from there, He saw two other brothers, James the son of Zebedee, and his brother John. They were in a boat with Zebedee their father, preparing their nets, and He called them. ²² Immediately they left the boat and their father and followed Him.

{come up one at a time}

How We Miss the Point (~Misteach the Sermon)

- Guilt & Do better
- Hesitation/Not ready
- The Cost
- 2) Clarity about the Cost
 - → Why did they immediately leave and so quickly follow ...?
 - a) The cost illustrates the value of Who they would be with and what they would now (immediately) be part of = the Kingdom!
 - b) The cost also reflects their confidence in Christ.
 - \rightarrow I believe in Jesus vs. I have confidence in Him.

What if the real cost (unbearable) is missing the King & His Kingdom?

Matthew 4:23-25

Now Jesus began to go all over Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the good news of the kingdom, and healing every disease and sickness among the people. ²⁴ Then the news about Him spread throughout Syria. So they brought to Him all those who were afflicted, those suffering from various diseases and intense pains, the demon-possessed, the epileptics, and the paralytics. And He healed them. ²⁵ Large crowds followed Him from Galilee, the Decapolis, Jerusalem, Judea, and beyond the Jordan.

Jesus' Ministry:

- His authority
 - Declaration & Demonstration
- His presence is the Kingdom
 - "Here & Now" AND "Then & There"

Matthew 5:1-2a

When He saw the <u>crowds</u>, He went up on the mountain, and after He sat down, His <u>disciples</u> came to Him. ²Then He began to <u>teach them</u> ...

- 3) Commitment to learn and to become (which certainly includes obedience to the King) as a product of devotion to the King and a lifestyle with Him.
- A) See the Kingdom vision: enthralled with, captivated by, hungry for ...
 - Leaving AND following
 - It's the "following" that brings about the "leaving"
- B) Give our intention
 - Increase our "immediately"
- C) Fix (turn, focus) our minds

We bring the reality of God into our lives by making contact with Him through our minds, and our living/lifestyle flows from that contact.

John 6:63

Clear & Present Dangers:

- What we "admit" into our minds and how it affects our thinking → living
- Overconfidence & pride in what "I think" and "I feel"
