God's presence is the **defining reality of David's life.**

God's presence is the **point.**

- **Genesis 1:1a** -- In the beginning, God ...
- **I Peter 3:18a** -- For Christ also suffered once for sins, the righteous for the unrighteous, that he might **bring us to God** ...

Psalm 27:2-3 (ESV)

When **evildoers** assail me to eat up my flesh, my **adversaries and foes**, it is they who stumble and fall. ³Though an army encamp **against** me, my **heart** shall not fear; though war arise against me, yet I will be **confident**.

God's presence is **not the only presence in our lives but for David, His presence is a **prevailing** presence.**

Role of fear (worry, stress, anxiety): follow it back into your heart and name it.

→ That “presence” is a potential **rival or competitor** to God.

Psalm 27:4a (ESV)

One thing have I asked of the Lord ...

Psalm 27:4 (ESV)

One thing have I asked of the Lord, that will I seek after: that I may **dwell** in the house of the Lord **all** the days of my life, to gaze upon the **beauty** of the Lord and to **inquire** in his temple.

To realize & recognize that God is with us in life-changing, eternity-altering, and joy-sustaining ways.

Facts About God's Presence:

- Prevailing
- Possibility of all day consciousness
- Beautiful
- Captivating // Rewarding

**Goodness: as a product of some positive condition, development, or result
vs.**

Goodness of God: inherent; in His very nature

Can we be with God, relate to God, enjoy God just for Himself?

We have some things to learn, unlearn and overcome.

Psalm 27:5-6 (ESV)

For he will hide me in his shelter in the day of trouble; he will conceal me under the cover of his tent; he will lift me high upon a rock. ⁶And now my head shall be lifted up above my enemies all around me, and I will offer in his tent sacrifices with shouts of joy; I will sing and make melody to the Lord.

Faith: reliance/trust/confidence revealed in attitude & action

→ **Seeing God as He REALLY sparks FAITH!**

3 Types of Faith:

- Socially acceptable (culturally proper)
- Desperation
- Sufficiency

Psalm 16:1 (ESV)

You make known to me the path of life; in your presence there is fullness of joy; at your right hand are pleasures forevermore.

A word about “worship”

- We are all worshippers
- God is worthy of our worship
- Our worship must be God-centered & focused

Psalm 27:7 (ESV)

Hear, O Lord, when I cry aloud; be gracious to me and answer me!

Psalm 27:8 (ESV)

You have said, “Seek my **face**.” My **heart** says to you, “Your **face**, Lord, do I seek.”

Psalm 27:9-14 (ESV)

Hide not your face from me. **Turn not** your servant away in anger, O you who have been my help. **Cast me not off; forsake me not**, O God of my salvation! ¹⁰For my father and my mother have forsaken me, **but the Lord** will take me in. ¹¹**Teach me** your way, O Lord, and lead me on a level path because of my enemies. ¹²Give me not up to **the will** of my adversaries; for false witnesses have risen against me, and they breathe out violence. I **believe** that I shall look upon the **goodness of the Lord** in the land of the living! ¹⁴Wait for the Lord; **be strong, and let your heart take courage**; wait for the Lord!

The Five Commitments of Coram Deo:

- 1) To know the **fear of the Lord**
- 2) To make holy **appraisals** (assessments, evaluations)
- 3) To identify as a **disciple** (student)
- 4) To seek the **will of God** as a **way of life**
- 5) To cultivate the ability to **focus on God**
