BIBLE MEMORY

Record and Replay

The Word of Wonder for the Hanging Out with Jesus series includes one of the most well-known verses in the Bible! Work together as a family to commit John 3:16–17 (both verses!) to memory. Start by putting the verses to a simple tune, either an original or a song everyone knows. Practice it several times. Then when you're ready, record everyone singing it on a phone or tablet. Then replay it at certain points every day, such as in the car on your way to school, before dinner, and at bedtime.

(If memorizing both verses at once feels overwhelming, simply start by memorizing John 3:16. Once everyone has it down, add verse 17 to your family's song.)



WALK IT ACT IT MOVE IT

Pack a Picnic

Remind your child that Jesus loves them and wants to hang out with them! Through the Holy Spirit, Jesus is with His followers, which means we can hang out with Jesus everywhere we go, including on picnics! Invite the whole family to have a picnic. If you live where the weather is cold, choose a cozy place indoors for your picnic, like inside a blanket fort or in front of a fireplace. If the weather is warm, plan on heading outdoors! Pack a picnic together; it can include a full meal or just a snack and drinks. Resist the temptation to take additional activities with you. Rather, enjoy the conversation that arises during your picnic.

End your family picnic by praying together as a family and thanking God for all the ways that He loves us. Take a family photo to capture your picnic!
