SERIES INVITATION

With the arrival of Easter, I am provoked to two extremes of feeling. I feel excitement and hope as I picture the children coming to celebrate Christ's resurrection. But, as I start to prepare and think about everything that needs to get done, I also feel anxious and overwhelmed. I fall into the trap of getting so busy "doing God's work" that I miss the real work that God wants to do within me.

I wonder about the root of my anxiety. Why do I believe the lie that only I can do the task at hand? Let's spend a few minutes slowing down and talking with God in silence. Read 2 Corinthians 5:17.

This verse reminds us that, through Jesus, we are made new. Our former fallbacks—pride, reliance on works, self-promotion, self-justification—are part of the old. They are gone! Through Jesus, we are free to live surrendered to the will of God, in the safety of His perfect love, no longer having to prove ourselves to anyone. So, reminded of that truth, how do you feel going into Easter?

Let's celebrate the wonder of being created new! It's not something we deserve by our own merits but something we are given by God's grace, through His Son, Jesus Christ. Let's lead, love, and launch the next generation to live wonder-filled lives that show God's power to conquer sin and create them (and us!) anew!
