ENGAGE & CONNECT ||

MEMORIZING SCRIPTURE ||

DISCUSSION ||

1. Have someone read Luke 19:28-42. Why does Jesus weep in the Bible?
2. Do you already experience the fullness of God, or is there more you still have yet to encounter?
3. Have someone read Acts 1. What do we not get to know? What does God give us instead?
4. On a scale from "hardly ever pray" to "totally devoted to prayer" where do you find yourself?
5. What would need to change for everyone in our group to be totally devoted to prayer, like the apostles here were?
6. Have someone read Acts 2. Is Peter's sermon a reasonable explanation for how many people received the gospel?
7. What are some of the signs in this scripture that the Holy Spirit had really changed people's hearts?
8. What are some of the signs that the Holy Spirit has really changed your heart?
9. Do we need a fresh filling of the Spirit of God? What should we do to get ready for more of Him?

## STEP OF OBEDIENCE ||

Things will change when God's people are together, devoted, and expectant.

*As you consider your next step, reflect on:* 1) What in your life needs to change to be ready for more of God? 2) How can the group get ready together for more of God's Spirit?

## PRAYER FOCUS ||

### Do it Again

We need You to accomplish the Great Commission—it must be Your Spirit that does it, not our cleverness or our skill. Will You do it again?"*
